The City of Bellaire will be hosting a Celebration of Independence on Tuesday, July 4, 2023. Please read all the information before completing the packet.

- ❖ **NEW START TIME:** Parade Begins promptly at 9:00 A.M from South Rice and Valerie
- ❖ **Check-In:** Parade entries will enter from Mimosa Dr. and South Rice Ave. between 7:30 – 8:30am. Only the vehicles registered in the parade will be allowed in the staging area. Parking will **NOT** be allowed on South Rice Ave.
- ❖ The parade will start at South Rice and Valerie St, please see map included.
- ❖ Parade participation is free, and decorations are strongly encouraged, but the parade is limited to the first 50 entries! All entries will be judged.
- ❖ You will be assigned a parade number on Tuesday, June 27 – You are responsible for printing and displaying the number in your windshield when you check-in.
- ❖ During the parade, make sure there are three car lengths in front of you and behind you and that your parade entry number is displayed.
- ❖ Throwing or passing out of candy or promotional material will **NOT** be allowed.

Please make sure you understand the parade route, a map of the parade route is attached to this packet. Parade route begins at the intersection of South Rice Ave. and Valerie St. The Parade will go north on South Rice Ave. and end at the intersection of South Rice Ave. and Linden St. Parade numbers and information packet will be e-mailed Tuesday, June 27, after 1:00PM.
